Literacy



This week, we have read and discussed two books: '**Mrs Pirate**' and the '**The Night Pirates**'. We have then looked at rhyme, completed rhyming strings and have also written our own lists.

In **Phonics**, we have revised all the sounds learnt so far as we have come to the end of 'Letters and Sounds Phase 2'. We continue to practise blending the sounds together to read words and segmenting them to write.
