## Monthly Overview

Year 3  
*March 2019*

### Literacy

Across the curriculum the children will be looking at a journey from Cape Town to Baghdad – taking in the geography, art and some of the stories along the way.

Therefore, during March the children will be looking at Myths and Legends from Africa. In their writing they will be working on developing Dialogue and Character.

### Computing

The children will be looking at aspects of E-safety and being a Digital Citizen – how to behave on-line.

It is a great opportunity to talk to them about what they are viewing, how much time they spend on-line and the positive and negative impact of technology in our lives.

### Daily/Weekly

The children will receive their homework and instructions on Tuesdays and it should be returned by the following Sunday. Any questions about homework should be directed to the class teacher on Wednesday or Thursday.

### Mathematics

In maths the children will be looking at measurement. For example, they will learn to measure accurately in millimetres, centimetres and metres. They will practice drawing lines to certain lengths and making accurate shapes.

They will learn to convert between some measures of length i.e.

Between millimetres and centimetres.

Between centimetres and metres.

It is important that the children practice their 10 times table and also practice dividing by 10 to be able to do this work well.

This work will link closely to their learning later in volume and capacity where we will start looking at millilitres and litres.

### Science

In science the children will be re-visiting and moving on from their learning on animals and humans from last term.

We will be looking closely at how humans grow and change during their lives, but **not** at the physical changes during puberty.

They will learn how we grow before we are born comparing this to other animals; like Elephants at 18 months to an Opossum at 12 days! Then how we become babies/toddlers then children, adolescents, adults and then move into old age.

We will move onto nutrition and health as we move on.

### How to help your child

Please read with your child every day.

Practice their times tables every week.

Ensure they have quiet time and space to complete their homework.

Review their Grammar, Punctuation and Grammar work in their CGP book.
