Literacy

This week we have been ascribing meanings to marks we see in different places. For this we began by investigating the different signs that we see around school and what they mean. We then looked for directional signs when visiting Santa's Grotto.

Phonics: we have continued with oral blending. We focused on listening to phonemes (the single sounds) within words and to remember them in the order in which they occur. We continued to break the words down and blend back together, such as: d-o-g, dog. Then we had a go at counting the sounds we could hear. We used our fingers to count up to three sounds in a word.
