





Literacy

This week, we finished our re-writing of **Jack and the Beanstalk**.



As we retold the story we looked at different sentence starters such as *Once upon a time*, *One day*, *On his way* and *The next morning*. We continued writing our own versions of the story, using our story maps to help us remember story sequence and our sentence starters to help us remember important story language. We have enjoyed watching our friends perform this story on stage and in the class!

In Phonics, we have continued to revisit the sounds in Phase 3 such as **(long) oo**, **(short) oo**, **oi** and **ow**. We also reviewed the tricky word **all**. Please utilise the Phonics blue book to practise and review all the tricky words, sounds and word banks with your child over the break.


