

Treasure



This week, the children have been sharing what they know about treasure and discussing what they want to discover and explore during this topic. They have also decided on how to change the class' role play area to a 'treasure' themed one.

Literacy



This week in Literacy, the children have been reading **'The Magic Key'** as well as using their imagination to write about where their magic key would take them.

In **Phonics**, we have focussed on the letter sounds **h, b, f** and **ff** and have been revising all the sounds learnt so far. We have also been blending these sounds together to read, and segment them to write. We have also reviewed tricky words **no, go** and **to**. As well as learned new high frequency words, **his** and **him**.

Please continue to practise all the letter sounds and tricky words at home.

We will celebrate **Black and Orange Day** on **Thursday 1st November.**




Please send your children to school wearing their costumes. We look forward to seeing you all on the playing field at 2pm for our parade.
