Treasure

This week, the children have been learning about the amazing discovery of Tutankhamun's tomb and lots of interesting discoveries about the Ancient Egyptians, too! The children had fun making masks and crowns for themselves so they can pretend to be pharaohs. They also attempted to write their names, even simple messages to each other, using Hieroglyphics! There were many archaeologists in FS2 this week, digging for tombs and treasures! They've even had a go at wrapping each other up like mummies! It was so much fun and very interesting too!



Literacy

This week in **Literacy**, the children have been learning all about Egyptian Treasures.



We have discussed how lucky we are in Egypt to have such great historical treasures like the pyramids, sphinx and the amazing temples in Luxor and Aswan.

They have also learnt that Egypt has many incredible natural treasures too, such as the coral reefs, deserts and the river Nile.

The children found out lots of facts about Egyptian treasures and then did some fact writing for our class book.

In **Phonics**, we have reviewed all the phase 2 sounds and tricky words. We have then spent the week focusing on blending sounds to read words and segmenting words for writing. We have also looked at reading and writing simple captions.

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

تدرب الأطفال على تمييز شكل وصوت (ش) في الكلمة من خلال بعض الكلمات مثل (شجر- شمس- عُش).

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Maths





This week in Maths, we have been looking at different types of measurement. The children have learnt about the concept of capacity. They have begun to use the language of capacity, such as 'full', 'half full' and 'empty', and have been comparing the capacity of different containers. They have used their problem solving skills to find ways to measure capacity.

Children have also been looking at the concept of weight, using the words 'heavier' and 'lighter' to compare the weight of objects, and using their problem solving and reasoning skills to figure out how to directly compare the weight of different objects using non-standard measurements.
